As we completed our first quarter of 2019, we show a surplus in our treasury -- Praise God.

At the end of March, we had a surplus of a little more than \$10,000!

We have paid all our bills, our apportionment and the first set of real estate taxes.

We praise God for his faithfulness and to our congregation for their faithfulness.

With that said, however, we still have not returned to paying somebody to clean the church.

In the past 20 months, 18 volunteers have spend hours each week cleaning seven different portions of the church. This has saved us in excess of \$20,000!

That combined with other expenditure reductions -- and increased giving -- is what has allowed us to have a surplus.

Some of those volunteers need a break!

If you would be willing to help clean some of the church, please notify Chuck Groger at 382-8722. He has the description of the seven areas.

You don't need to clean EVERY week, but if you would consider cleaning some to give those dedicated volunteers a break, it would be appreciated. You could work out a schedule so they aren't responsible every week nor would you be.

An ideal situation would be if we could gather enough volunteers so only once a month would be needed.

Cleaning is the basics -- empty waste baskets, run vacuum, polish, dust and mop floors where needed.

Please pray about this and see where God may use you in a small way -- but an important ministry.
